## A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A YOUTH ADVISORY BOARD

**WHEREAS**, the City of Simpsonville recognizes that community issues are youth issues and that young people are affected by **all** the decisions made by local government; and

**WHEREAS**, the City also believes that local government should be accessible to young people and give them meaningful opportunities to weigh in on community issues; and

WHEREAS, as city councils are the local government representatives most in touch with children and youth in communities and should be listening to the voices of young people; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to help provide Simpsonville youth with opportunities to participate in local government and interact with city leaders;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City of Simpsonville, as follows:

- 1. That a Youth Advisory Board be established that gives young people a voice through an active role in their city government while teaching them how local government works; and,
- 2. That City Council may give direction and assign tasks, such as researching an issue, to maintain a working relationship with the Board; and
- 3. That the City Administrator develop and establish rules, guidelines, and qualifications to ensure the Board fulfills its purpose and function.
