

A RESOLUTION

COMMITTING THE CITY OF SIMPSONVILLE TO PROVIDING A LOCAL MATCH FOR A MUNICIPAL ASSOCIATION OF SOUTH CAROLINA HOMETOWN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GRANT AND FOLLOWING ITS PROCUREMENT POLICY WHEN SECURING SERVICES AND PRODUCTS WITH GRANT FUNDS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SIMPSONVILLE here assembled on this 8th day of September 2020, that the City of Simpsonville hereby commits to provide a cash match of at least \$3750, which equals the minimum 15% local match required by the Municipal Association of South Carolina, to support the City of Simpsonville's application for a \$25,000 Hometown Economic Development Grant. These grant and local matching funds will be used for the engineering, design and surveying of Phase 2 of the Swamp Rabbit Trail from Fairview Road to Heritage Park.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City will follow its procurement policy adopted in accordance with the SC Code of Laws Section 11-35-50 when securing all services and products purchased with funds awarded from Hometown Economic Development Grant.

This resolution is made in regard to the submission of an application for Hometown Economic Development Grant funds to the Municipal Association of South Carolina on or before September 25, 2020.
