2017 Basketball Draft Process

Player Evaluations (All players should attend evaluations except for head coach's child)

- During the, coaches administered, evaluation each head coach will rate all players present with a number value 1-5 (5 being best).
- The ratings from each head coach will be turned in to the Athletic Staff at the end of the evaluation session(s).
- Staff will average all ratings sheets for each player and assign a final value to each player for the purposes of the next step in the draft process. Players who do not attend will be placed into the random assignment pool.

<u>Draft</u>

- The head coach's child is automatically on his/her roster.
- Head Coach may have one assistant coach the assistant coach's child will be part of the draft process
- Based on the average ratings from evaluations, staff will group players by round if there are 6 teams in the league the top 6 rated players will be randomly assigned in the first round to rosters, then the 2nd group of 6 and so on until all rated players are on a roster.
- Once all rated players are assigned to a roster all players who did not attend will be randomly assigned to a roster until all available players are on a roster.
- The rosters will then be assigned a name and presented to the group of head coaches for a 2nd evaluation during this time as a group the coaches will assess the equality in each roster, players may be swapped within the same round they were assigned only during this part of the process.
- Once all coaches agree that the rosters are as evenly matched as possible the team names will be placed in a blind draw and each coach will select to see which roster they get – the head coaches child automatically goes with that group – the assistant coaches child again must be moved/swapped within the same round they were assigned.
- Once the number of players and all trades are complete there will be another final coachs' group assessment of all rosters once agree the process was as fair and even as possible rosters are final.
- Trades for friends are allowed but must follow within the same assigned round as above and must be viewed as fair by all coaches.
